**8. Attachment of Centre for Peace & Strategic Studies to the Faculty of Arts**

Attachment of the Centre for Peace & Strategic Studies to the Faculty of Arts, to empower the Faculty to confer the degrees (M.A. & Ph.D) being offered by the Centre.

**9. LUBCON Nigeria Limited's Prizes/Scholarship/Research Fund:**

The Senate approved the proposal from LUBCON, Nigeria Ltd on the followings:

(a) **Scholarships:**

Worth ₦50,000 each, annually to a total of 20 students. Four of these students would be selected on merit, while the best student from each of the 16 Local Government Areas of Kwara State would equally be selected after the administration of a qualifying test, with effect from the 2009/2010 Session.

(b) **Research Fund:**

An endowment of the sum of 10,000 dollars annually for research or Sabbatical in a discipline related to the company's business interests. Senate is to decide the beneficiary.

(c) **Prizes:**

A seed money of N2.5 million Naira each for the award of two prizes of ₦250,000 each, annually, to:

- (i) the best graduating student in any discipline of Engineering, to be known as **LUBCON Nigeria Limited Prize**; and
- (ii) the best graduating female student to be known as **Mariam Prize for the Best Female Graduating Student**. This would be jointly managed by both the Company and the University.

**10. Examination Administration: The Process of Seeking Redress by Students**

Senate approved the two forms to be used for processing application for redress of examination results. The forms are as attached. Senate re-emphasized and modified the procedure as follows:

- (a) The student fills a "Result Verification Form" (in triplicate) obtainable from the Office of the Deputy Registrar (Academic).
- (b) The Deputy Registrar (Academic) shall give an instant acknowledgement by signing, stamping and giving a copy to the student, indicating the time and date.
- (c) A copy of the "Result Verification Form" shall be sent to the HOD concerned by the Deputy Registrar (Academic).
- (d) The HOD, within one week, shall issue to the student, the verified result either confirming the old score or reflecting the new one. A copy shall also be forwarded to the Deputy Registrar (Academic).
- (e) Where a review occurs, the HOD is under obligation to give reasons and forward a copy of the Verification Report through the Dean to the:

\* Director of Academic Planning and

\* Deputy Registrar (Academic)

- (f) In case the student is still not satisfied with the result, he/she shall obtain a "Re-mark Request Form" from the Deputy Registrar (Academic). The Form shall be filled and submitted to the same office.
- (g) The Deputy Registrar (Academic) shall request for the Marking Scheme of the Course from the HOD concerned and forward it, together with all the scripts of the Course and the Student's "Script Re-mark Request Form," to the Deputy Vice-Chancellor, (Academic).
- (h) The Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Academic) shall pick at random, scripts including that of the complainant, and oversee the process of remarking.
- (i) The Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Academic) shall submit a report to the Vice-Chancellor not later than four weeks from the submission of the Scripts Re-mark Request Form.
- (j) The Vice-Chancellor, and the under listed:
- \* Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Academic),
  - \* Dean of the concerned Faculty,
  - \* Director of Academic Planning,
  - \* Chairman, Committee of Deans,
  - \* Dean, Student Affairs and the
  - \* Head of Department concerned
- shall meet to consider the final report on the re-mark and forward same to Senate
- (k) Where an Examiner is found to have willfully and deliberately victimized a student, the matter shall be referred to the Staff Disciplinary and Appeals Committee.

The Federal Government has approved a radio licence for the University and the radio station is to be known as **Unilorin FM**. When fully operational, days would be set aside for every Faculty and related Centres, which would be named after individual Faculty/Centre.
