With 39 medals, including the most coveted football gold medal, the University of Ilorin emerged 4th best team out of 73 universities listed on the medals table at the just concluded NUGA Games in Lagos.

The Better by far Team UNILORIN gathered 11 gold medals, 12 silver medals and 16 bronze medals at the 26th edition of the games hosted by the University of Lagos between March 16 and March 27, 2022.

In the 25th edition hosted by the Federal University of Agriculture, Makurdi, in 2017, the University of Ilorin emerged 6th out of 57 universities with 5 gold, 14 silver and 11 bronze medals.

Team UNIPORT emerged overall winner of the tournament with 61 gold, 29 silver and 30 bronze medals. Team Unilag who are the hosts of the tournament, sealed their second place with 33 gold, 34 silver and 19 bronze medals.

Nile University, Abuja, the only private University in the top five, picked 15 gold, 10 silver and 13 bronze medals to finish third on the log.

Benson Idahosa University from Edo State, who were ranked third in the 2017 edition of the tournament, won the Fair Play Award.

Team UNILORIN's Football Captain, Sodiq Ajao, was named the Most Valuable Player in football.

A breakdown of Team UNILORIN's medals haul shows that in athletics, Abibat Adesina, Kaothar Jimoh, Musa Nurain and Taiwo Sasere picked silver medals in walk race, 800m, 100m and 110m hurdle respectively. Musa Nurain picked his other medal in 200m race as he emerged third to add bronze to his medals.

In Chess, Ojonugwa Stella Ocheja, a 400-level student of the Department of Anatomy, picked a gold medal while Alexander Olayinka Aina of the Department of Chemical Engineering recorded a bronze medal for the team.

The UNILORIN Warriors picked the most precious gold medal

in football after defeating Obafemi Awolowo University 5-4 on penalties after a goalless draw in regulation time.

In Scrabble, a 300-level student of the Department of Accounting recorded a silver medal for Team UNILORIN in singles event. Akeem Ogundokun and Opedimeji Rasak-Oyadiran of the Department of Surveying and Geoinformatics also picked a bronze medal in doubles.

Raufiat Abdulazeez won a gold medal in squash (women's

singles). Raufiat, Bukunmi and Sofiat, recorded a gold medal in women's team event while Bukunmi and Raufiat teamed up to pick a silver medal in women's double event.

In the men's doubles, Uthman Durosinlohun and Abdulraheem Durosinlohun won a silver medal. Uthman also picked a bronze medal in the men's singles before teaming up with Raufiat Abdulazeez to win bronze in the mixed doubles.

The University of Ilorin Taekwando team recorded a historical feat by emerging as the top most ranked side as Fareedah Aderibigbe won two gold in Bantam Weight (Female) and Poomsae (Female Individual). Aderibigbe and Adefenwa Yusuf also won a silver medal in Poomsae (Pairs) category.

In the Light Weight Female category, Sherifat Hassan picked a gold medal for Team UNILORIN while Oluwadarasimi Owopetu recorded a bronze medal in Fin Weight Female (46KG).

In Badminton, Team UNILORIN came second on the medals table after recording 3 gold, 1 silver and 1 bronze medal behind Ahmadu Bello University, Zaria, that came first with 3 gold, 1 silver and 2 bronze medals. Sofiat Obanishola won Gold in Female Singles for Team UNILORIN before pairing with Usman Qudus Afolabi to clinch another gold medal in mixed doubles event. The team of Sofiat, Khadijat Babatunde, Oluwatosin Abe and Hajarat Salman also won gold in Female Team event for the Better By Far institution. In the men's doubles, Usman Qudus and Oluwatosin Oyedele won a silver medal while Sofiat Obanishola and Kadijat Babatunde recorded a bronze medal in

women's doubles.

A 400-level student of the Department of Human Kinetics Education, Afeez Adetunji, won a gold medal in Karate's individual kata (form) category. The karate team also recorded three silver and six bronze medals. The silver medalists include Abdullateef Akolade Muhammed, Bashir Oyindamola Abdulkadir and Bayo

Rafiu Ayinla (Male Team Kata). Babajide Oluwaseun Adeleye of the Department of Human Kinetics Education clinched a silver medal (-84 category male kumite). Abeebah Musbau, a 100-level student of the Department of Anatomy won the other silver in +68 Female Category.

The UNILORIN Karate Team that made its first appearance at the Nigeria University Games (NUGA) won a Silver Medal in T20 (10 overs) after a 45-44 run win over Team Uniport and a Bronze Medal in ODI after defeating Team Unilag by 60-45 runs.

The female handball team and

the Male Basketball Team also reached the semifinals at the tournament.

In his immediate reaction, the Vice Chancellor of the University of Ilorin, Prof. Sulyman Age Abdulkareem, congratulated the athletes on the feat achieved for the institution.

The Vice Chancellor, who was represented at the tournament's closing ceremony penultimate Saturday by (March 26, 2022) by the Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Research, Technology and Innovation), Prof. Mikhail Buhari, expressed satisfaction with the overall performance of the athletes.

It will be recalled that the UNILORIN Sport Council at the 2021 Academic Session's Sport Awards, promised to reward athletes who won medals for the University.

The immediate past Chairman of the Sport Council, Prof. Gafar Ijaiya, said that the Vice-Chancellor was committed to the promotion of sport excellence through adequate welfare package for the institution's sportsmen and sportswomen

The team competed in Athletics, Basketball, Chess, Football, Judo, Table-tennis, volleyball, Scrabble, Squash, Swimming, Taekwando, Handball, Volleyball, Cricket, Badminton and Karate.

VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT FOR THE POST OF VICE-CHANCELLOR

Introduction

The Council of the University of Ilorin hereby announces to the general academic community that the post of Vice-Chancellor of the University will be vacant with effect from 16th October, 2022.

In accordance with the provisions of the Universities (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act No. 11 of 1993, as amended by Act No. 25 of 1996 and The Universities (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Amendment) Act 2012, the Council has decided to commence in earnest the due process of appointing a new Vice-Chancellor. Consequently, applications are hereby invited from suitably qualified candidates for the position.

A Brief History of the University

Established by the Federal Government of Nigeria in 1975, the University of Ilorin is one of the fastest-growing public Universities in Nigeria with an enviable record of academic excellence. The University has been the most sought-after University by candidates in the past five (5) years.

The Vision of the University is to be an international centre of excellence in learning, research, probity and service to humanity, while the Mission statement is to provide a world-class environment for learning, research and community service. The University guides jealously its core values which are coined to encourage inclusiveness in its operations. These core values are: Excellence, Integrity and Transparency, Empathy, Justice and Fair Play, Innovation and Creativity, and Team Work.

The University has sixteen (16) Faculties, (one) 1 College of Health Sciences, (six) 6 Institutes, twenty (20) Centres, including a Centre for Open and Distance Learning, thirty-three (33) Directorates, and a Postgraduate School, with a student population of over 52,000 and a total staff strength of 3,745. The University prides itself as one of the most stable Universities in Nigeria, where academic activities are carried out in a serene, peaceful and friendly environment, with students completing their programmes as and when due. The students and staff composition is truly diverse with a healthy mix of national and international population.

Academic Excellence

The University has carved for itself a niche in the areas of teaching and applied research. For example, the University has, at various times, been ranked best in research and development and other academic endeavours. Of recent, the University ranked 7th in the overall ranking of Nigerian Universities by the National Universities Commission (NUC), 3rd in Federal Universities category and 1st in the North-Central Geopolitical Zone category. It was also ranked 2nd in Nigeria by the Times Higher Education (THE) in February 2022. It is one of the two Universities ranked A+ in the only Institutional Accreditation of Nigerian Universities by the National Universities Commission (NUC), 2011/2012 session, thereby earning a 7-year full institutional accreditation status.

The Position

The Vice-Chancellor shall, in line with the Act establishing the University, be the Chief Executive and Academic Officer of the University and shall exercise general supervision over the University. The Vice-Chancellor shall be Ex-Officio Chairman of Senate, Congregation and a member of the University Governing Council. The Vice-Chancellor shall be responsible to the Council for the day-to-day management of the human, financial and material resources of the University.

The Ideal Candidate

The ideal candidate for the post of the Vice-Chancellor, University of Ilorin, shall:

- be a distinguished Professor of not less than 10 years as at 16th October, 2022 in one of the disciplines offered by the University of Ilorin;
- have demonstrable and astute managerial abilities to maintain the peace, inclusiveness and academic stability for which the University is reputed;
- be a scholar of outstanding national and international repute, with proficiency in Information and Communication Technology (ICT), and have considerable experience at top levels of University Administration;

- be a Professor with a track record of teaching, research and community service;
- be a person of entrepreneurial and innovative pre-disposition, with a proven track record appropriate to the vision and mission of a first class University;
- be a person endowed with strong character and ability to give courageous and effective leadership;
- be a person capable of inspiring the advancement of learning and reaching out to all persons;
- be of a sound health, pleasant disposition, unassailable integrity and strong moral character for inspiring and maintaining moral discipline among staff and students; and
- have proven ability to initiate contacts and funding from national and international sources.

All claims shall be verifiable with evidences.

Applicants are required to submit along with their applications, 30 hard copies and a soft copy of a statement of the candidate's vision for the University in the next five years in not more than 1,000 words and not less than 600 words.

Conditions of Service

The appointment shall be for one term of five years only, while salary and other conditions of service shall be as approved for Vice-Chancellors of Federal Universities by the Federal Government and the Council.

Application should be submitted (in a sealed envelope clearly marked at the top left corner, "Application for the Post of Vice-Chancellor") to the Registrar and Secretary to Council, University of Ilorin, P.M.B. 1515, Ilorin, Nigeria, not later than 3.30 p.m. on Monday 16th May 2022 (six weeks from the date of this advertisement).

Following the expiration of the tenure of Prof. Lanre Tajudeen Ajibade, the new Dean of Student Affairs, Prof. M. T. Yakubu, has assumed duties at the institution's Student Affairs Unit.

Prof. Yakubu of the Department of Biochemistry assumed duties last Monday (March 28, 2022) along with the new Sub-Dean, Dr. D. Ojo of the Department of Geography and Environmental Management as well as the new Deputy Registrar, Student Affairs Unit, Mrs. M. S. Zakariyyah of the Registry Unit.

Speaking with UNILORIN BULLETIN at the Dean's office shortly after meeting with other stakeholders of the Unit, Prof. Yakubu, who appreciated the management of the University for his appointment as the new Dean, also thanked the immediate past Dean, Prof. Ajibade and the Sub-Dean, Dr. Alex Akanmu, for the achievements recorded during their tenure.

Prof. Yakubu, who disclosed that he is very lucky having among the hard working staff of the University to work with, also added that among his office mandates is to keep and maintain the University's better by far status.

The new Dean, who was Sub-Dean, Students Affairs between 2010 and 2012, said that he understood little about the environment, adding, "With what these put together blessed and very good staff and with the arrival of the new DR-Students, I am optimistic that by the special grace of God we shall add more positive impacts to what we met."

The Dean, who added that he would work as a team with the Sub-Dean and others, said, "We shall work together, agreed together, talk together".
