I am proud to announce that our university has achieved remarkable milestones in terms of ranking, both nationally and internationally. This is a testament to the hard work and dedication of our faculty, staff, and students. In a demonstration of our strong determination of becoming the best in Nigeria, our university has moved up the ranking ladder of leading ivory towers in Nigeria and for the 10th consecutive year, we again topped the list of most sought-after University in the country for the 2023 Unified Tertiary Matriculation Examination (UTME).

The University continued to enjoy the support of TETFUND as an intervention fund of \$954,732,123.00 was allocated to the University by TETFUND for year 2023 to cover eleven (11) specific areas. Equally, the University received TETFund award of Five Hundred Million (\$500,000,000.00) hostel accommodation for our students and Two Hundred Million (\$200,000,000.00) for Zonal Interventions. The University is using the funds to execute different projects.

Research and innovation are the lifeblood of our institution. The university produced 4 patents in 2021/2022 academic session and currently has a total of 36 patents with the Federal Government of Nigeria through the National Office of Technology Acquisition and Promotion (NATOP), Abuja. With this, University of Ilorin is one of the highest contributing institutions to patency in Nigeria. The number of our patents in the various disciplines are: Medical 5, Agriculture 5, Engineering 16, Food 1, Information Technology 4, Petrochemical 3, Defence 1, Energy 1. The various patents are currently being positioned for commercialization.

The remarkable achievements of our students are a source of pride for me as I recognize their outstanding talents, dedication, and hard work. The achievements of our students serve as a testament to the quality of education and opportunities that our institution provides. In the spirit of fostering an environment of learning, innovation and growth, our students have excelled in a myriad of fields, setting a standard of excellence and commendation.

Distinguished ladies and gentlemen, I am proud to showcase the summary of the successful students graduating from the University of Ilorin in the 2021/2022 academic session. A total of 10,757 students will be convoking for the 38th Convocation Ceremonies. In the First Degree/Diploma category, we have 239 First Class, 3,406 Second Class (Upper Division), 4,691 Second Class (Lower Division), 961 Third Class and 21 Pass. The 38th Convocation Ceremonies also include 160 MBBS graduands, 87 Nursing graduands, 15 Optometry graduands, 35 Veterinary Medicine graduands, and 26 graduands with Distinction and 43 graduands with Pass in Pharmacy. Thus, we have 9,684 graduands in the First Degree/Diploma category. Furthermore, the total number of Higher Degrees to be awarded at the 38th Convocation Ceremonies is 1,073. Out of this figure, there are 60 Postgraduate Diplomas, 605 Masters from various Faculties, 211 Professional Master's Degrees, and 197 PhDs.

I want to use this medium to appreciate the personnel of the Registry department, particularly, the Student Affairs and Academic Support units who within a few days worked assiduously with the National Youth Service Corps (NYSC) to mobilise 8,290 of the 9,684 graduands of the just concluded 2021/2022 academic session for the next batch of service. This appreciation also extends to the staff of COMSIT, Faculty Officers, Level Advisers, Course Lecturers, Heads of Departments, and Deans of Faculties who worked tirelessly to ensure the results were ready and presented to the Business Committee of the Senate (BCOS).

I must acknowledge the Chairman of the BCOS, Professor Abayomi Olubunmi Omotesho (the Deputy Vice Chancellor, Academics) for his unrelenting efforts to galvanise members of the BCOS to prepare and present the graduating class of the 2021/2022 Academic Session.

In conclusion, I want to express my sincere appreciation to all our guests, family members, and friends who have joined us to celebrate this Convocation. Your support and encouragement have played a crucial role in the success of our graduates.

To the graduands, I offer my warmest wishes for a future filled with accomplishment, fulfillment, and the pursuit of your dreams.
