- Over 70 special needs students had graduated in various Departments e g one Medical Doctor, 2 lawyers(male and female),5 Engineers, Educators and others .
- Also, one PhD. student in Educational Technology graduated and other Postgraduates in various departments
- Recently, other categories of students with special needs were also admitted,
 e.g.,
- Visual impairment (blind), physically challenged students, and other students with health challenges
- The current total number of students with special needs in the Centre is 90.
